**INCIDENT: Hyde Park Police announce charges in recent burglary**

The Town of Hyde Park Police Department announces that charges have been filed against one adult and one juvenile in the burglary of a residence on Mansion Drive that occurred on October 20<sup>th</sup>. In this incident, the rear door of the residence was kicked in and over \$5,500 worth of jewelry and electronics was stolen from the home; the house was completely ransacked.

Hyde Park Police recovered some of the stolen jewelry and were able to identify a suspect; it was then learned that the Town of Poughkeepsie Police Department was also investigating a similar pattern of burglaries, and a joint investigation was then commenced. The City of Poughkeepsie Police Department was also brought into the investigation, and multiple suspects were identified and followed. A number of arrests were made early last week, and through the course of the investigation, two of the suspects were identified as having committed the Mansion Drive burglary. Hyde Park Police have since recovered all of the jewelry and a number of the electronic items taken from the home in that incident.

Hyde Park Police have lodged charges against 19-year-old Johmir Alexander Miller, of 109 Delafield St., Apt. 40, Poughkeepsie. Miller is already in custody, and in the Dutchess County Jail, on charges from the Town of Poughkeepsie Police Department. He will be charged with Burglary 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree, a Class C Felony; and Grand Larceny 4<sup>th</sup> Degree, a Class E Felony. A juvenile will also be charged with Burglary 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree in the Hyde Park incident; that case will be processed in Family Court.
