**INCIDENT: Police charge two deli employees with theft from business**

Hyde Park Police have arrested two employees of the K & D Deli on Route 9G on larceny charges, after they were observed taking various items out the back door of the store during the early hours of Saturday morning.

At app. 4:39AM on that date, police were called to 848 Violet Ave. after 46-year-old Raymond McCauley and 48-year-old William Hapeman were observed removing a number of items from the store, using the back door of the building. It is alleged both suspects took various items, including cheese, cigarettes, bread, cereal, laundry detergent and soda. An agent for the business also told police that a review of the store's surveillance video system has revealed over a dozen previous incidents in the last few weeks involving both suspects.

Both suspects were taken into custody and brought to Hyde Park Police HQ, where they were booked on charges of Petit Larceny. Both suspects were released to reappear in Hyde Park Town Court on December 23<sup>rd</sup>.
