INCIDENT: 16-year-old student charged with drug sales in high school

Hyde Park Police have arrested a 16-year-old Hyde Park resident, who is also a student at FDR High School, on felony drug charges after an investigation into the sales of hydrocodone pills on school grounds.

School officials and Hyde Park Police Officer Martin Monaco, the school resource officer at FDR High School, launched an investigation after the student was observed acting in a suspicious manner in the school. The investigation led to the discovery of twenty-three (23) hydrocodone pills in the student's possession; it further revealed that the student is alleged to have been selling the pills individually in one of the bathrooms at the school. The pills were seized and turned into evidence, and student was taken into custody and brought to HPPD for processing.

The suspect was arraigned before the Hon. Judge Kennedy, and released to reappear in Hyde Park Town Court on December 14th.
