**LOCATION: 4676 Albany Post Road, Hyde Park (The Ledges Apts.)**

**INCIDENT: Suspect charged in trespassing incident also found in possession of stolen credit card, wanted on County Court warrant**

On Thursday morning at app. 9:30 AM, Hyde Park Police were called to the Ledges Apartments on Route 9 for a report of a unauthorized person inside a vacant apartment. The caller, an agent of the complex, told police that she had observed a man inside of an unoccupied apartment; when she confronted him about being there, she stated he fled on foot in a southerly direction. A window screen was found to be damaged, but it was unclear if he had entered the apartment in that manner. It was determined that he had been residing with a woman at another apartment at the Ledges, but had been thrown out of that residence some days earlier and had apparently been sleeping in the vacant apartment.

Hyde Park Police Officer Jason Ruscillo located the suspect on Albany Post Road, and placed him into custody for Criminal Trespass. It was learned at that point that the suspect, identified as 30-year-old Andrew Irvin of Hyde Park, also had an active County Court warrant from August 2<sup>nd</sup> of this year.

Once at HQ, Irvin's property was inventoried; it was then discovered that he was in possession of an American Express credit card that did not belong to him. The person to whom the card belonged was contacted, and stated he had been awaiting the arrival of the card in the mail; Hyde Park Police are still investigating whether Irvin had taken the card directly from the mailbox of the victim, but at this time have charged him with the unlawful possession of the item.

Irvin was processed at HPPD and brought before the Hon. Judge Steinberg; bail was set at \$20,000 cash/bond on the Hyde Park charges, with a return date in Hyde Park Town Court of December 7<sup>th</sup>. He is also being held on the County Court warrant.
