INCIDENT: Hyde Park Police seek public's help in larceny investigation

The Town of Hyde Park Police Department is seeking assistance from the public in attempting to identify two subjects being sought for questioning in a larceny that occurred at Williams Lumber on Wednesday, February 23rd. Sometime between 10:50 AM and 11:20 AM on that date, a white male and white female entered the store and walked through several aisles looking at merchandise. Some time after they left, an item with an approximate value of \$299 was found missing, and it is believed they may have been involved.

The white male seen in the photos is in his mid 20's, wearing blue jeans, white sneakers, a grey sweatshirt with a hood, a black coat and a black ball cap which is worn at an angle such that the brim sticks upward.

The white female is also in her mid 20's, dark hair in a ponytail, wearing a long black coat, a white sweatshirt underneath, and plaid or possibly pajama pants.
