INCIDENT: Hyde Park Police advise the public to be aware of recent burglary and vandalism complaints

The Town of Hyde Park Police Department wishes to make the public aware of a string of recent burglaries and incidents of criminal mischief. People are always encouraged to contact Hyde Park Police at 229-9340, or call 911, to advise the authorities of any suspicious activity that is observed.

Hyde Park Police are currently investigating burglaries of the main building at Hackett Hill Park on E. Market St., which occurred early last week; and at the Knights of Columbus on Route 9G, which occurred yesterday afternoon. During that incident, three suspects (possibly juveniles) were seen running from the building; a State Police K-9 Unit was called in to conduct a track, but the suspects were able to flee the area.

Hyde Park Police have also taken reports of four (4) separate acts of vandalism in the last several days. These incidents include damage to a home, a street sign being torn down, a car windshield being broken, rocks thrown through stain glass windows at Regina Coeli Church, and security lights at Pine Woods Park being broken.

While the public is encouraged never to engage a suspect(s) in these types of incidents, police are asking that any suspicious activity or groups of individuals be reported to the local authorities.
