**LOCATION: Cardinal Road, Town of Hyde Park**

**INCIDENT: Hyde Park Police charge suspect with felonies after theft of firearms and other items**

This past Tuesday evening (06/21), Hyde Park Police were called to a residence on Cardinal Road to investigate the theft of a number of items from the home, including but not limited to four (4) shotguns, a rifle, a compound bow, two (2) swords and a number of power tools. Police spoke to several family members at that location, and it was learned that a relative from out of state who had been staying there for the last two months may have been responsible for the thefts.

The investigation revealed that a number of the items had already been sold, and officers were able to determine the location of the firearms; the discovery of the weapons subsequently led to the recovery of all of the items that had been stolen. Police recovered a Marlin .22 cal. rifle, three (3) Remington 12 gauge shotguns, a sawed-off 12 gauge shotgun and a 20 gauge shotgun; as well as both swords, the bow and the other items.

Hyde Park Police have charged 25-year-old Christopher Weaver of Hyde Park with two counts of felony Grand Larceny; Weaver was arraigned last night in Hyde Park Town Court before the Hon. Kennedy. He was remanded to the Dutchess County Jail on \$20,000 cash / \$40,000 bond; a preliminary hearing has been set, and Weaver is due back in Town Court on June 28<sup>th</sup>.
