PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

HURRICANE IRENE – ROAD CLOSURES AND TRAFFIC

***** Updated Monday 12:35 PM*****

At the time of this writing, the following roads in the Town of Hyde Park are closed:

- Crum Elbow Road, east of Cardinal Road
- **Haviland Road, east of Roosevelt Road IS NOW PASSABLE**
- South Cross Road, in the area of # 44
- North Cross Road (bridge still under repair)
- Brower Blvd.
- Old Post Road – damage to bridge near Norrie Point
- Roosevelt Road, near Valkill Drive (tree down)
- **Roosevelt Road / Bill Reynolds Blvd. IS NOW PASSABLE**
- Roosevelt Road, from # 205 to # 212
- **Route 9G is now re-opened (south of St. Andrews Road)**
- Beck Road, near East Dorsey Lane
- **The traffic light at Route 9 and West Dorsey Lane is now functioning.**
- Just a short time ago, yet another motorist attempted to drive around the barricades and through the water on Crum Elbow Road; the car became disabled and rescuers were called to the scene. Motorists are **AGAIN** urged to use common sense and not drive their vehicles through standing water.

Motorists and citizens are reminded that the Town of Hyde Park is still in a state of emergency.
