LOCATION: Silver Fox Lane, Town of Hyde Park

INCIDENT: Police announce arrest of Georgia man after burglary investigation

Early last week, Hyde Park Police opened an investigation into a burglary on Silver Fox Lane in the Town of Hyde Park. The investigation revealed that a Georgia man was staying with a female acquaintance on that road, and it was determined that the subject, later identified as 38-year-old Warren Rogers of Atlanta, GA, had in fact broken into a residence on Silver Fox Lane and had stolen some clothing and a number of other items from that premise. Police were able to determine the location of some of that property, and were able to recover a number of the items.

Police learned that Rogers had fled the location on Silver Fox Lane and may be located at an apartment complex in Hyde Park; officers determined his location and took him into custody without incident this past Thursday afternoon. He was brought to Hyde Park Police Headquarters, and was booked on a number of charges; he was arraigned before the Hon. Judge Steinberg and was remanded to the Dutchess County Jail on \$15,000 cash / \$25,000 bond. Rogers is scheduled to reappear in Hyde Park Town Court on Wednesday.
