INCIDENT: Man Arrested for Burglary

On April 2, 2012 at approximately 12:22 AM the Hyde Park Police received a call a person acting suspicious on Lyons Drive. The caller said a male was sitting at the end of the road and he was acting suspicious. The caller stopped and spoke to him and he said he was waiting for a cab. Just prior to patrols arriving at the scene the caller called back and said he just left in a taxi cab. A call was placed to the cab company and they reported they picked him up and were currently in the Town of Poughkeepsie. Patrols and Detective located the subject Rae Paul Steele Jr in Town of Poughkeepsie and brought him back to Headquarters for questioning. During the Investigation it was determined that the subject had Burglarized a home on Lyons Drive and stole numerous items that were found in his possession.

Steele was arrested for charges below and arraigned in front of Judge David Steinberg and remanded to Dutchess County Jail without bail. He is due back in Hyde Park Court on April 4, 2013 at 6:30 PM.
