LOCATION: Staatsburg

INCIDENT: 2 Men Charged with Burglary

On October 12, 2013 the Hyde Park Police responded to a residence in Staatsburg for a report of a past occurred burglary. The homeowner was out of town and the caretaker came to check on the house this date and noticed things inside to be moved. It appeared someone had been in the house. Patrols arrived and immediately began an investigation. The Hyde Park Police Department Detective Division took over the investigation. When the homeowner returned to take an inventory of what was taken it was determined that over \$875.00 worth of property was missing. Items included us currency, jewelry, tools and a play station were taken. After a lengthy investigation Steven E Boles a 27 year old male from New Paltz, and Jeffrey A Amato a 26 year old male from New Paltz were arrested and some property was recovered.

Amato was arrested on January 9, 2014 and charged with Burglary in the 2nd Degree and Petit Larceny He was arraigned in front of Judge Kennedy and was remanded to Dutchess County Jail on \$500.00 cash or \$1,000.00 bail bond. Amato is due back in Hyde Park Justice Court on February 11, 2014 at 10:30am.

Boles was arrested on January 15, 2014 and charged with Burglary in the 2nd Degree and Petit Larceny. He was arraigned in front of Judge Kennedy and remanded to Dutchess County Jail on \$10,000 cash or \$20,000 bail bond. Boles is due back in Hyde Park Justice Court on January 17, 2014 at 12:00 pm.
