INCIDENT: 2 more suspects arrested in HVFCU Robbery

. On October 8, 2014, at approximately 8:39 am the Town of Hyde Park Police Department, the Dutchess County Sheriff's Office and the New York State Police responded to the report of a robbery at the Hudson Valley Federal Credit Union on Route 9 in the Town of Hyde Park. The investigation revealed that prior to the robbery, an individual was carjacked in the Town of Hyde Park and this victim's vehicle was used in the robbery.

During the investigation Police determined that there were more suspects involved in the Robbery that were not yet arrested.

That investigation led to an arrest warrant being issued for William I McKinney a 21 year old male from Fort Washington Maryland. Hyde Park Police Detectives went to Maryland on October 17, 2014 with the assistance of the Federal Bureau of Investigations Violent Crimes Cross Border Task Force, Prince George's County Police Department of Maryland took McKinney into custody. McKinney was sent to Prince George's County Department of Corrections in Maryland where he is awaiting extradition back to New York.

While the Hyde Park Police were in Maryland apprehending McKinney the Dutchess County Sheriff's office Detective Division arrested Bianca King a 20 year old female from Highland. King was arraigned in front of Judge Kennedy and remanded to the Dutchess County Jail on \$100,000 bail bond or \$200,000 cash. She is due back in Hyde Park Justice Court on October 23, 2014 at 1:00 pm. King was an employee of the Hudson Valley Federal Credit Union as a teller, she was involved in planning and execution of the robbery.

Starting this week the Dutchess County District Attorney's office will be presenting this case to the Dutchess County Grand Jury. More details will be given once the case is presented to the Grand Jury and more charges are anticipated.

This is a great example of multiple law enforcement agencies working together to help solve a violent felony case as this one. The Hyde Park Police Department would like to thank the following agencies for their assistance and expertise in this case: Dutchess County Sheriff's Department, Town of Poughkeepsie Police, Village of Rhinebeck Police, Town of Lloyd Police the New York State Police Major Crimes and Computer Crimes Division, Federal Bureau of Investigations Violent Crimes Cross Border Task Force, Prince George's County Police Department of Maryland, Dutchess County District Attorney's Office, Dutchess County Probation. The Hudson Valley Federal Credit Union Risk mitigation department was very helpful with the investigation.
