INCIDENT: Hyde Park Man Arrested for Burglary

On November 13th 2014, officers from the Hyde Park Police Department responded to the Green Tree Drive Development located off of State Route 9G In the Town of Hyde Park for a reported past occurred residential burglary. The victim reports that she came home to find that someone had entered her home through a window and moved furniture to gain access into the victim's home. After looking through the home the victim noticed that most of her jewelry and some of her personal belongings were stolen. Responding officers did a preliminary investigation and conducted a crime scene at the residence.

The case was forwarded to the Hyde Park Detective Division where the investigation continued. On 11/21/2014, detectives report the arrest of Brandon M. Hildwein 24year old male from Hyde Park. Hildwein was arrested for the Burglary. Hildwein was arraigned at the Town of Hyde Park Court and remanded to the Dutchess County Jail on \$10,000 cash or \$10,000 bond. The defendant is due back in court on 12/18/2014 at 6:30pm.

The Hyde Park Police Department would like to reiterate to the public to please be vigilant in keeping an eye out in your neighborhood.
