INCIDENT: Wappinger Falls man charged with Burglary

On November 27, 2015 the Town of Hyde Park Police was dispatched to 394 Violet Ave for a past occurred commercial burglary. The workers reported someone broke into the building and stole copper piping. Later on patrol officers found a vehicle matching the description of a vehicle believed to be involved in the previous burglary parked behind the business with copper piping in the back of the car. The Hyde Park Police Department contacted the Dutchess County Sheriffs office to utilize their k-9 for a search. While the K-9 was searching a patrol officer noticed a male identified as Brian Gimenez walking down the road and stopped him to talk to him. He was detained and interviewed. After that interview he was taken into custody and charged with two counts of Burglary, Criminal Mischief, and Petit Larceny.

Gimenez was arraigned in front of Judge Steinberg and remanded to the Dutchess County Jail without bail because he has been previously convicted of two felonies and is currently on parole. Gimenez is due back in Hyde Park Justice Court on December 3, 2015 6:30 pm.
