INCIDENT: Hyde Park Man charged after rash of vehicle break-ins

The Town of Hyde Park Police Department have been investigating a rash of recent vehicle break-ins. Within the past few months we have received several reports of vehicles being entered and items of value stolen from these cars. The items stolen range from loose change, iPods, jewelry, wallets containing credit cards, winning scratch off lottery tickets, cologne and other items.

Hyde Park Police Department patrol and detective division identified a suspect and brought him in for questioning. After the interview the Hyde Park Police Department arrested Kain R Brown a 24 year old male from Hyde Park.

Kain was processed and arraigned in front of Judge Joseph Petito and remanded to Dutchess County Jail on \$10,000 cash or \$20,000 bail bond. He is due back in Hyde Park Justice Court on Monday March 28, 2016 at 6:00 PM.

The Hyde Park Police want to make sure all residents keep their vehicles locked and don't leave items of value inside your vehicle in plain sight. Most of these vehicle larcenies come from a vehicle that was not locked. One of the first crime prevention methods is to always lock the doors of your vehicle, residence and other buildings that may contain items of value.
