### PRESS RELEASE

On May 27, 2016 at approximately 11:07 am, the Town of Hyde Park Police Department was dispatched to the Chase Bank located at 4277 Albany Post Road for a reported armed bank robbery. The first responding Town of Hyde Park units arrived within two minutes and were subsequently joined by units from the Town of Hyde Park Police Department, New York State Police, Dutchess County Sheriff's Office and the Town of Poughkeepsie Police.

According to bank employees, the suspect was a light skinned black male wearing a mask, grey and white sweatshirt and placed his hand in his pocket leading them to believe he had a handgun. The suspect then left the bank on foot and ran to a parked car and fled in an unknown direction. Both the Town of Poughkeepsie Police K-9 unit and the New York State Police K-9 units conducted tracks of the area which led to a possible location where the car was parked. Video evidence from local business and home owners in the area was collected and helped determine that the suspect vehicle was a black Toyota Corolla.

On Wednesday June 1, 2016 investigators observed a vehicle fitting that description driving north on State Route 9G in the Town of Hyde Park. The vehicle was stopped and the female operator identified. The following day the operator of that vehicle was brought into the Town of Hyde Park Police Department for questioning. Information developed during this interview and the investigation led police to Dequan L. Bryan who was located in the City of Poughkeepsie. Bryan was subsequently arrested and charged with Robbery in the First degree, a class B felony.

The joint investigation was conducted by the Town of Hyde Park Police Department uniformed and detective division, the New York State Police uniformed, K-9, Bureau of Criminal Investigation, Major Crimes Unit, Computer Crimes Unit and Forensic Investigation Unit. The Dutchess County Sheriff's Office and the Town of Poughkeepsie Police K-9 division also assisted at the scene of the robbery. The City of Poughkeepsie Police department assisted at the scene of the suspects' apprehension on Barclay Street in the City of Poughkeepsie.

Bryan was processed and arraigned in front of Hyde Park Town Judge Petito and remanded to Dutchess County Jail on \$50,000 cash or \$100.00 bail bond. He is due back in the Town of Hyde Park Justice Court on Monday June 6, 2016 at 5:00 pm.
