Payment Policy:

All programs *require* pre-registration. A non-refundable deposit of \$25 per child per week is required upon registration. In order to secure your registration, you must pay the balance due 2 weeks before the start of each session. If full payment has not been received by 2 weeks before the start of the session, we have the right to void your registration. **Refunds:** Refunds are issued only in the case of an extended illness with a doctor’s note. **Cancellations:** We retain the right to cancel a program due to low enrollment. Refunds will be granted in this case. **Returned Check Fee:** Our Town is charged a \$30 bank fee which will be passed on to the customer. The funds need to be satisfied by certified check, money order, or cash. **Please note: There is a \$15 fee for changing your registration less than 2 weeks before the start of each session.**

2018 Hyde Park Recreation Adventure Day Camp Summer Registration and Swim Lessons Form

Our 2018 Adventure Day Camp runs for seven weeks, from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm, Monday thru Friday, rain or shine. Children must have completed kindergarten by June 2018, and can be no older than 13 by the end of the camp week. The camp is located at Hackett Hill, but older groups may go on walking trips, to the movies, or for ice cream. The camp provides an opportunity to participate in many fun activities with their peers such as; arts and crafts, nature, theme, small group activities, swimming, and special events on Fridays. Hackett Hill is inspected and regulated by The Dutchess County Board of Health. Staff receive a mandatory pre-season camp training and are certified in CPR and First Aid as required by law. **Early Bird Registration:** April 1-30: 10% discount for this day camp.

Beck Park

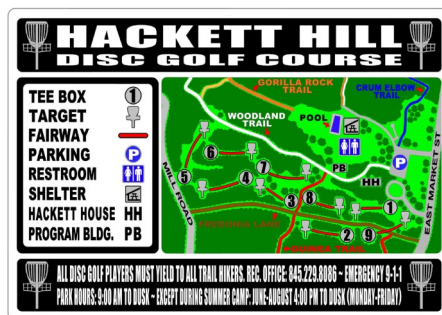
E. Dorsey Lane & Beck Road: Playground, basketball court and multi-purpose field.
