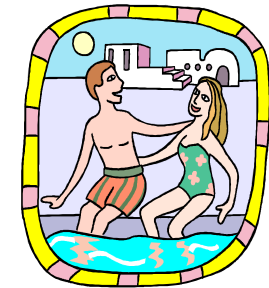

## Summer Camp

## Camp Medical Records

. All Campers must have a 2010 “Health Information Sheet & Waiver “ on file by June 15. These medical forms are available on our Town’s website ([www.hydeparkny.us/recreation](http://www.hydeparkny.us/recreation)). Any camper who attended a Town of Hyde Park day camp in 2009 does not need to submit a new “Immunization Record” unless the Camper has had updated immunizations within the year. If your child requires medication, you must have your Doctor complete a special signed Medical Release Form required and submit before June 15, 2010

1. “Create an “Activenet” account “ - In order to register for day camp or obtain a membership, you must create an account..
- 2) “Purchase a membership” - Only if you are a resident of Hyde Park can you become a member . This gives you a special rate.
- 3). “Register”- After you have created an account ,you can then register each session of camp or session of swim lessons.
- 4). “Check out”—After you have registered, you can finish the registration process by using your credit card. A deposit of \$25. will hold your registration until two weeks before the start of camp. Your balance must be paid off two weeks before the start of each session.

**Early Bird Discount**—Residents only can take advantage of our “Early Bird” Registration from April 1-15, 2010 . In order to receive the 10% discount, full payment is required at this time. Please note: If you want to change weeks after April 15, the will not apply and you will be charged the difference.

**Payment Policy:**All programs *require* pre-registration. All programs have limited availability. A non-refundable deposit of \$ 25. per child per week is required upon registration. In order to secure your registration, you must pay the balance due 2 weeks before the start of each session. If full payment has not been received by 2 weeks before the start of the session, we have the right to void your registration.

**Refunds** - Refunds are issued only in the case of an extended illness and a doctor’s note.

**Cancellations** - We retain the right to cancel a program due to low enrollment. Refunds will be granted in this case.

**Returned check fee**— Our Town is charged a \$20. bank fee which will be passed on to customer. The funds need to be satisfied by certified check, money order or cash.

**Liability** - We do not carry medical insurance for participants. All participants must complete and sign health/waiver forms releasing the Town from claims of personal or property damage.

## Level 1 - 6 Swimming Lessons from the American Red Cross



Ages 5 -13 ( must have completed Kindergarten). Children are placed in appropriate level the first day. 1/2 hour classes run Monday - Friday in 2 –week sessions. These classes are taught by certified Water Safety Instructors using “Learn to Swim” method. Learn to Swim teaches aquatic and safety skills.
