

Summer Recreation Intern Program Information & Application

Summer 2017

The Summer Recreation Intern Program is a youth development program for young people who are 14 and 15 years old. It consists of several parts:

- Learning and practicing job search and employment skills through the application process, interviewing and an employment-type experience.
- Completion of our three-day summer staff development course end of June (TBA).
- Learning and applying childcare and leadership skills.
- Personal evaluation throughout and at the end of the program.

The main part of the program is the learning how to supervise children, run games and activities and work with other staff as part of the team. THE Intern Instructor will train and supervise the Interns with daily activities . You will gain experience working along side trained staff during the day in the Adventure Day Camp. Interns assist with the program and help supervise campers. They are given some responsibility and they are well supervised by our regular staff. There are 2x three week sessions.

and one last week of day camp that you may volunteer to work.

Participants who successfully complete the program can apply to work for the Recreation Department in our summer programs upon turning 16 years old.
