



TRAIL MAP Vanderbilt Mansion National Historic Site

Please Remember

- Park open sunrise to sunset.
- Bicycles permitted on lower shared bike-foot trail.
- Stay on marked trails.
- Park only in designated parking lots.
- Carry out what you carry in.
- No fires. Do not disturb plants, wildlife or artifacts.

Hike Safely

- Wear clothing & footwear appropriate to season and terrain.
- Some trail sections are along public roads. Be aware of traffic hazards.
- Ticks which can spread Lyme disease are common here. Avoid brushing against vegetation. Use insect repellent.
- Poison-ivy grows abundantly here.
- Drinking water is not available along the trail - be sure to bring your own.

Trail Descriptions

You are free to explore however you like. Here is one suggested hike:

From the main parking area, walk north along the paved road to reach Bard Rock and the Hudson River. This was the site of the Vanderbilt Boat House.

A shaded, unpaved carriage road leads 1.1 miles south along the railroad, with occasional river views. The trail returns to the paved road at the River Gate House (a private residence.) Note that bicycles are also permitted on this trail.

Continuing up the hill, the trail leaves the paved road and brings you to the splendid formal gardens, maintained by the Frederick Vanderbilt Garden Association. It returns north to the Mansion and Visitor Center.
